

## Communities That Care Student Survey Data Eudora Schools – 2009

### FREQUENCY OF USE IN THE PAST 30 DAYS

*Scale Question: On how many occasions (if any) have you had beer, wine or hard liquor during the past 30 days? (GPRA Indicator)*

- 2007 – 31.6% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 29.1%)
- 2008 – 36.2% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 27.2%)
- 2009 – 27.8% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 26.9%)

*Scale Question: On how many occasions (if any) have you used marijuana during the past 30 days? (GPRA Indicator)*

- 2007 – 11.4% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 8.1%)
- 2008 – 9.4% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 7.8%)
- 2009 - 5.4% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 7.9%)

*Scale Question: How frequently had you smoked cigarettes during the past 30 days?*

- 2007 – 15.3% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 10.8%)
- 2008 – 17.6% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 10.4%)
- 2009 – 9.3% of students report “at least once” (Kansas – 10.0%)

### RISK FACTOR - VIOLENCE

*How many times in the past year have you been in a fight on school property? (GPRA Indicator)*

- 2007 – 13.10% of students report “1-2 times” (Kansas – 12.6%)
- 2008 – 12.8% of students report “1-2 times” (Kansas – 11.3%)
- 2009 – 11.4% of students report “1-2 times” (Kansas – 11.1%)

*During the past year, how often did you miss school because you felt unsafe, uncomfortable or nervous at school or on your way to or from school? (GPRA Indicator)*

- 2008 – 5% of students reported “sometimes 1-2 times per month” (Kansas – 8%)
- 2009 - 6.8% of students reported “sometimes 1-2 times per month” (Kansas – 8.2%)

### AGE OF ONSET OF ANY DRUG USE

**Alcohol:**

- 2007 – 13.0 (Kansas – 12.90)
- 2008 – 13.37 (Kansas – 12.99)
- 2009 – 13.02 (Kansas – 13.01)

**Marijuana:**

- 2007 - 13.6 (Kansas – 13.70)
- 2008 – 13.69 (Kansas – 13.79)
- 2009 – 13.62 (Kansas – 13.83)

**Tobacco:**

- 2007 – 12.6 (Kansas – 12.50)
- 2008 – 12.39 (Kansas – 12.68)
- 2009 – 12.65 (Kansas – 12.78)

## RISK FACTOR – BULLYING

*Scale Question: During this school year, how often have you seen someone being bullied?*

- 45.2% of students reported “sometimes, 1-2 times per month” (Kansas – 40.9%)
- 13.1% of students reported “regularly, 1-2 times per week” (Kansas – 17.7%)
- 9.7% of students reported “everyday” (Kansas – 12.9%)
- 32.1% of students reported never (Kansas – 28.6%)

*Scale Question: During this school year, how often have you been bullied at school?*

- 20.1% of students reported “sometimes, 1-2 times per month” (Kansas – 21.5%)
- 4.8% of students reported “regularly, 1-2 times per week” (Kansas – 5.6%)
- 1.7% of students reported “everyday” (Kansas – 3.4%)
- 73.4% of students reported never (Kansas – 69.6%)

*Scale Question: If you saw bullying at school, what would you do?*

- I haven’t seen any bullying (Eudora – 45.7%) Kansas – 36.6%
- Ignore it as it is none of my business (Eudora – 43.2%) Kansas – 49.7%
- Nothing, just watch (Eudora – 6.7%) Kansas – 10.2%
- Join in on the fun (Eudora – 4.4%) Kansas – 3.5%

*Scale Question: During this past school year, how often have you had your property stolen or deliberately damaged, such as your car, clothing, or books?*

- 67.6% of students reported never (Kansas – 71.4%)

*Scale Question: What do adults do at school when they see bullying?*

- Nothing, they ignore it (Eudora – 9.6%) Kansas – 9.6%
- Stop it and tell everyone to leave (Eudora – 17.2%) Kansas – 23.8%
- Stop it and solve the problem (Eudora - 61.6%) Kansas – 57.8%
- Other (Eudora - 11.6%) Kansas – 8.8%

## ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS

*Scale Question: During the past 30 days, how did you usually get beer wine or hard liquor?*

- 75% did not drink
- 8% gave someone older money to buy it
- 2% borrowed it from someone else
- 7% reported an older person gave it to them
- 2% took it from a store or family member
- 7% got it some other way
- no one reported getting it from a retailer

*Scale Question: During the past 30 days when you drank beer, wine or hard liquor, where did you drink it?*

- 75% did not drink
- 1% drank it in their car
- 7% drank it at their home
- 14% drank at a friend’s home
- 3% drank it somewhere else (other)
- no drinking was reported at bars or school or at a park or outdoors

Total Survey Participation Rate for 2009 – 86.9%

6<sup>th</sup> Grade – 91.1%

8<sup>th</sup> Grade – 89.8%

10<sup>th</sup> Grade – 87%

12<sup>th</sup> Grade – 75.6%
