

EUDORA SCHOOLS STUDENT FEES

Fee cap for families. The instructional supply fee that any family must pay is limited to \$100, regardless of the number of children. Fees for all-day kindergarten, out-of-district and driver education do not apply to this fee cap.

Fee payment. As allowed by Kansas state statutes 72-5390 and 72-5389, fees will be collected at the beginning of each school year, or at the time of enrollment for students transferring into the district midyear. Once paid, fees are in effect throughout the school year and are not refundable. There will be a \$30 fee charged on all returned checks. Fees not paid by May 31, 2012, will be collected through the Kansas Debt Setoff program. More information is available at www.da.ks.gov/ar/setoff.

Fee waivers. Assistance in paying fees will be available for students qualifying for the reduced lunch program (50% waiver) or the free lunch program (full waiver). This is determined based on size of household and gross income and is subject to state qualification. Appeals for a denial of waiver will be handled according to the free/reduced lunch program appeal process.

Parents wishing to apply for free/reduced lunch status must complete a Child Nutrition Program application and Waiver of Confidentiality, available at Cardinal Craze back-to-school fair in the fall, or from any school office. The following figures refer to annual gross income and are subject to change, as dictated by the state of Kansas.
