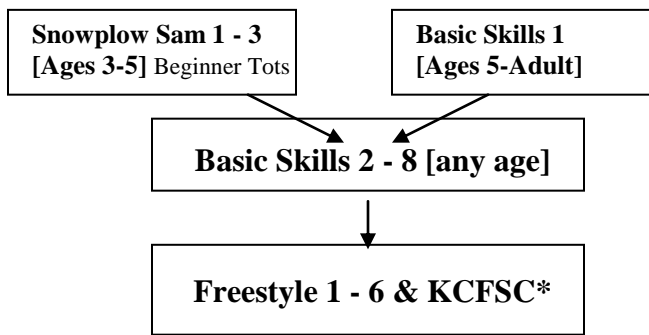
## Outlaws

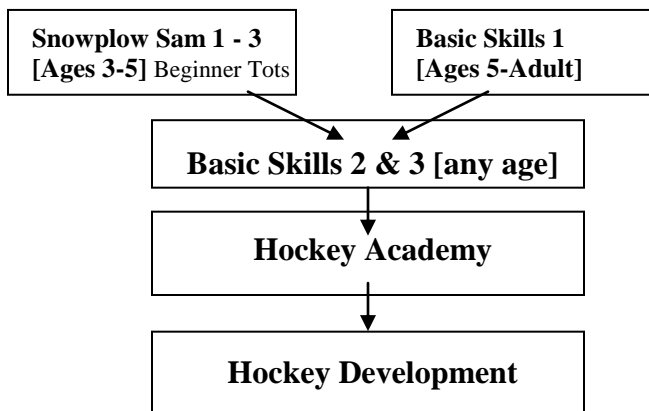
### LEARN TO SKATE CLASSES:

- Beginning skating classes for boys and girls as well as adults that want to learn how to ice skate. These classes will teach basic ice skating skills and fundamentals. They work on developing coordination and balance.
- Class includes free skate rental on day of class and one free public admission for each class in the session. Gloves & comfortable layered clothing is recommended.
