Expectations

1. Follow directions, classroom procedures, and guidelines in the student handbook.
2. Be on time in assigned seat prepared to learn and complete classroom tasks.
3. Respect others and their property.
4. No candy, food or drink (unflavored drinking water will be allowed),
5. No personal use of computers or cell phones.
6. Be seated in chairs with all chair legs on the floor, as well as your feet.
7. Backpacks and purses are to be closed and stored under your chair while in the classroom.

Grades will be figured by using total points. Daily work is worth 5 or 10 points (\approx 40% of quarter), tests and quizzes range from 20 to 200 points (\approx 60% of quarter).

Semester grade: 1st quarter-40%, 2nd quarter-40%, semester final-20%.

Daily work will be collected the day after it is assigned. Some assignments will be graded for completion, while others will be graded for correctness. Daily assignments will be posted on the board. Any student that is absent has the responsibility of requesting any assigned worksheets or notes, and completing missed assignments and notes. **Daily work that is turned in late** will receive no higher than a 60% and cannot be turned in after the unit has been completed.

Absences- follow the guidelines in the student handbook. Any daily worksheets that are assigned may be picked up from the envelope on the board.

Missed Tests- a student that misses the day when the test review worksheet is assigned will be allowed one day to make-up the test. If the student is present for the review and absent on the day of the test he/she will take the test the first day they return to class. Missed tests may be made up during class time although that will cause you to miss new content. It is wise to make arrangements to take the test before or after school.

Equipment

A 3-ring binder with two pockets and notebook paper or a spiral notebook with pocket dividers or a combination of the two. Each student will need to provide their own highlighter, red pen, pencil, and a scientific calculator. Students do not need to bring colored pencils and/or markers to class everyday but they will be used on projects throughout the year.

Classroom Procedures

Begin bellwork as soon as the tardy bell rings. Please allow me to complete attendance and other necessary communications without interruptions.

Tardy- anyone entering the doorway after the bell begins ringing without a pass will be counted tardy and is expected move to their assigned seat without distracting other students already at work.

Homework ready to review and/or grade and turn into the basket.

Do help your seat partners if needed in a whisper voice so that others can continue to work without distraction.

Leaving the classroom- is allowed during **study time** only when classroom instruction and directions are completed. Students needing to leave the classroom must sign out and sign back in upon return. Each student will be allowed only one pass per week. A student leaving the classroom is expected to return within a reasonable time. If additional time is taken without an appropriate reason the student will loose the privilege of using passes. If a student uses the restroom during the passing period and is tardy it will count as a tardy or the one allowed pass.

Stay seated in assigned seat unless told to do otherwise. You may get a Kleenex (or facial tissue), or sharpen your pencil without permission as long as the instructor is not lecturing or giving instructions.

Late or make-up work- should be marked appropriately and put in **basket** on the back counter.

Major and minors will be assigned according to school policies.

Be aware of your grade- Power School is available so that you can keep track of your progress in the class. Please keep returned assignments in the case that there is a discrepancy between what you think should be recorded and what is recorded.

End of class- Remain in assigned seat working on assignment until one minute remaining at which time books and supplies may be put away. Wait to be excused before leaving. The bell is my cue to excuse you.
