Eudora has four facilities to meet the needs of approximately 1,400 students:

- Nottingham Elementary (1965), K-2
- Eudora West Elementary (1994), 3-5
- Eudora Middle School (1995), 6-8
- Eudora High School (2002), 9-12

Eudora also is a partner in the Eudora-De Soto Technical Education Center, offering exceptional hands-on learning programs for high school students.

Technology is a priority in support of educational innovation, with more than 850 student and staff computers and educational technology resources.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Last year, Eudora Public Schools met the standard of excellence in 10 categories of the Kansas state assessment tests, including four building-level awards. With approximately 80 to 90 percent of students scoring at or above the standard, this marks the third consecutive year that Eudora students have far surpassed state requirements for AYP scores.

GROWTH & EXPANSION

The district has shown positive, steady growth at the rate of three to five percent each year since the 1990s. Voters approved a bond issue in November 2007 to accommodate growth with a new elementary school, new technical education center, additions to existing buildings and projects to further enhance the district's educational offerings.

RECENT ACHIEVEMENTS

- Top finishes at the state SkillsUSA competition qualified three Eudora students for the national contest, finishing fifth in the nation in screen printing, 13th in the nation in graphic communications, and 13th in the nation in food and beverage service.
- Varsity teams took high honors at the league, regional and state levels, including a first-ever state championship in volleyball, a league championship in football and a second-place state finish for softball. The girls' track team took first in regionals and finished second overall at state.
- Eudora choir director named Kansas Choral Directors Association young director of the year in Kansas for 2007.
- Eighth grader won the Douglas County Spelling Bee, earning a trip to the state bee.
- Student journalists brought home the regional sweepstakes award from the Kansas State Press Association contest, followed by a second-place finish at state.
- 2005 national graphic communications teacher of the year and state culinary arts teacher of the year.
