FACILITIES

Eudora has four attendance centers to meet the needs of more than 1,400 students: Nottingham Elementary (K-2), Eudora West Elementary (3-5), Eudora Middle School (6-8), and Eudora High School (9-12). Three of these four facilities have been built in the last 12 years.

OUR COMMUNITY

Eudora, Kan., with a population of 6,000+, is a friendly small town located less than 10 minutes from Lawrence and 20 minutes from the Kansas City metropolitan area. For this reason, Eudora offers the advantages of small-town living, with the benefits of a close proximity to major cities.

ACADEMICS

The curriculum in Eudora Schools combines a basic education objectives with additional opportunities in college preparatory and career studies. Teachers are afforded the time to collaborate with their peers, to design and align curriculum. Collaboration also as led to major success in student assessment. Last year, our students earned the Standard of Excellence in 10 categories of the Kansas State Assessment tests, including four building-level awards.

TECHNOLOGY

Eudora Schools can boast the availability of more than 850 computers and state-of-the-art technological instruments. The increasing availability of technology within the district gives our students the continuing ability to score well above average on the Kansas State Assessments and to maximize their potential in becoming effective workers, responsible citizens, and life-long learners.

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES

The Eudora School District is a member of the East Central Kansas Cooperative in Education, Interlocal #614. The ECK Co-op provides special education to students ages 3 to 21 in three school districts, including Eudora. Psychologists, speech-language pathologists, occupational/physical therapists, social workers, and many others are trained to work with various exceptionalities. The co-op also provides services for children with high intellectual ability, through enrichment and accelerated activities that augment the schools' curricula.

FUTURE OUTLOOK

With an average enrollment increase of three to five percent each year, we are focused on growth and development. We stand to greatly benefit from a highly educated, growing population that is extremely supportive of public education. The district also is always looking for innovative ways to tap into the rich intellectual and technological advances so prevalent along the K-10 corridor in eastern Kansas.
