**Fee payment.** As allowed by Kansas state statutes 72-5390 and 72-5389, fees will be collected at the beginning of each school year, or at the time of enrollment for students transferring into the district midyear. Online payments are available through the school district website and are subject to a convenience fee of \$3.00 per transaction. Once paid, fees are in effect throughout the school year and are not refundable. There will be a \$30 fee charged on all returned checks.

### USDA's National School Lunch & School Breakfast Program

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) is a federally assisted meal program operating in public and nonprofit private schools and residential child care institutions. Beginning on July 1, 2022, the federal government is no longer offering free meals to all students as a COVID relief option. As a result, the Federal Free and Reduced Meal program has been reinstated.

### Consent to Disclose

By agreeing to share your student's Child Nutrition Program status with school officials, Instructional fees may be free or reduced depending on the student's Child Nutrition Program status.

You do not have to agree to the Consent to Disclosure to receive free or reduced price Child Nutrition Program benefits. <b>Other fees.</b> <i>These apply to programs or opportunities that are limited by space; advance permission or registration is required.</i>	
<b>Quest after-school program</b> <i>Students in kindergarten through 5th grade.</i>	\$1,300 per year or \$130 per month. Cap of \$2,100 per family.
<b>The ZONE after-school program</b> <i>Students in grades 6-8.</i>	\$100 per year or \$50 per semester. Cap of \$200 per family.
<b>Out-of-district enrollment</b> <i>Required for students living in another district choosing to attend Eudora Schools.</i>	An annual fee of \$100 per student, or as outlined in Board Policy JBC, is required at the time of application. No fee waivers are available.
<b>Driver education (summer)</b>	\$225 per student, due at the time of driver education enrollment in the spring. No fee waivers are available.
